Re Winter Wonderland event community consultation

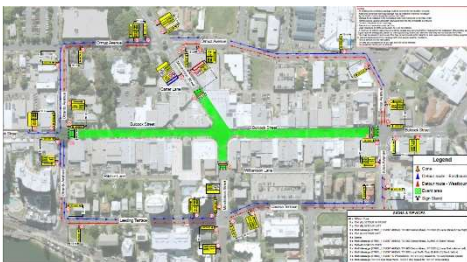
We are incredibly excited for this year's, **Winter Wonderland**, and would like to inform you of the details:

Date: Friday, 26 June 2026
Event Time: 4pm – 8pm
Location: Bulcock Street, Caloundra (Between Otranto Ave and Knox Ave)
Road Closure: 2pm – 10pm

With entertainment, market stalls, and street food this family friendly event, now in its fourth year, always receives great feedback, attracting thousands of people to Caloundra. This is a great opportunity for extended trade to showcase your business and take advantage of the additional foot traffic. We have intentionally schedule *Winter Wonderland* to be in the middle of winter, outside of school holidays, a time that is notoriously quiet.

Here is some information regarding the logistics of the event:

- ❖ Early next week, signage will be placed in Bulcock Street advising of the scheduled event road closure occurring on the Friday.
- ❖ **The road closure will commence at 2pm.**
 - The road closure will be in the same format as the Caloundra Street Fair and encompass the two blocks of Bulcock Street from Otranto Avenue to Knox Avenue and Minchinton Street between Carter Lane and Williamson Lane. Please refer to the below map.
 - Parking will continue to be available at the Transit Centre in Cooma Terrace, along with surrounding streets.
- ❖ Stallholders, vendors and entertainers will begin bumping in and setting up in groups after 2pm. At all times pedestrian access will be maintained in the precinct
- ❖ **Winter Wonderland will operate from 4pm – 8pm**
- ❖ **The road closure concludes at 10pm**
