### **Brisbane Road and surrounding streets, Mooloolaba**

### **Wednesday 21 July to Wednesday 28 July, 7am – 5pm**

**All works weather and site conditions permitting**

#### **About these works**

As part of the Brisbane Road upgrade, power infrastructure is being improved.

From July 21 – 28, between 7am and 5pm, Energex will be undertaking power pole replacements and overhead powerline relocations along Brisbane Road and surrounding streets.

To safely undertake these works and protect the community, some road lanes must be temporarily closed to traffic, and the power supply temporarily turned off in some areas.

While Energex works will take place from 7am – 5pm daily, all lane closures and power outages will take place between **9am and 3pm** only.

The 9am – 3pm timing has been determined to minimise impacts to traffic flow along busy Brisbane Road, allow residents to prepare for work/school (including school drop off and pick up), and ensure that local residents and businesses are not impacted by power outages at night.

Energex will contact all residents and businesses affected by the temporary power outage directly. Information will also be provided on how to prepare for the power outage.

More Energex works will be required in future. We will provide you with advance notice of these works, including any changes to power supply.

#### **What to expect during these works?**

New power poles will be delivered and stored on the side of the road along Brisbane Road (adjacent to Mooloolaba Bowls Club), Bindaree Crescent and Kyamba Court.

Energex will prepare the new power poles for installation on site. The old power poles will be swapped with the new ones, and overhead powerlines then transferred to the new poles.

Nearby residents and business can expect intermittent, medium level noise and the operation of heavy machinery including crane lift and elevated platform trucks and vacuum excavation equipment.

For safety reasons, exclusion zones will be applied around live overhead powerlines.

#### **Temporary changes to traffic conditions**

##### **Wednesday 21 July. Power pole delivery.**

Stop and go traffic control operating on Brisbane Road near the Mooloolaba Bowls Club and on Kyamba Court and Bindaree Crescent.

##### **Monday 26 July. Power pole installation and overhead powerline works.**

Stop and go traffic control operating on Brisbane Road near Bindaree Crescent and Kyamba Court. Temporary lane closures at Tarcoola Avenue/Brisbane Road intersection. Alternative pedestrian routes in place as required.

**Tuesday 27 July. Vacuum trucks operating.**  
Stop and go traffic control operating on Brisbane Road opposite the Mooloolaba Bowls Club.

**Tuesday 27 July, from 3pm onwards. Exclusion zone preparation.**  
On street parking will be temporarily unavailable along sections of Brisbane Road in the EnergeX exclusion zones (from Foote Street to Kyamba Court)

**Wednesday 28 July, 9am – 3.00pm. Power pole installations and overhead power line relocations.**  
On street parking will be temporarily unavailable along sections of Brisbane Road in the EnergeX exclusion zones (from Foote Street to Kyamba Court).

One lane of traffic will be operating on Brisbane Road between Kapala Street and Kyamba Court. Traffic control will be in operation.

Please allow an extra 10-15 minutes of travel time and see the map below for details.

**Access to homes and businesses.**  
Access will remain available for local residents and staff and customers of businesses. Traffic controllers will assist as required.

Temporary alternative pedestrian pathways and pedestrian crossings will be in place. Traffic control and signage will help to ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists and construction workers.
