Paynters Creek and Petrie Creek Road upgrade - Rosemount

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council has received funding from the South-East Queensland Community Stimulus Program (SEQCSP) to extend the dedicated cycle lane on Petrie Creek Road between Paynters Creek Rd and Sugar View Lane.

We will start early works at the Petrie Creek Road and Paynters Creek Road intersection to allow for service relocations. Please see Figure 1 for location of works.

Start date

Works are scheduled to start the week beginning Monday 11 August and are expected to finish by October 2025, subject to weather and site conditions.

Work will take place from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday. We appreciate your patience during the delivery of this work and look forward to improving this asset for our community.

We will make every effort to minimise construction impacts. If there are any interruptions to property access, a project representative will contact you to make arrangements.
