# Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade Project Stage 1B – Walan Street, Mooloolaba

Project number: H9272

Temporary changes to traffic conditions Walan Street and Venning Street, Mooloolaba Monday 1 March - Thursday 4 March (day works) (all works weather and site conditions permitting)

### **Unitywater works**

As advised in our previous construction notifications, Unitywater is undertaking water main connection works as part of the final Stage 1B Walan Street upgrade.

The next stage of these works involves a major water main located at the intersection of Walan and Venning Streets, Mooloolaba.

Unitywater will be conducting day works in this area over the next few days, with some temporary changes to traffic required on Walan and Venning Streets.

Works are expected to be complete and the roads returned to normal traffic conditions by 6pm Thursday 4 March 2021.

#### Temporary changes to traffic conditions

For safety reasons some temporary traffic changes must be implemented during these works including:

- The two **southbound** traffic lanes on Walan Street closed from Venning Street to Muraban Street. Traffic will be diverted around this area via a signed detour route.
- The two northbound traffic lanes on Walan Street will remain open.

- Access for residents of 18 Walan Street and to the businesses at 16 Walan Street will be available via Muraban and Walan Streets.
- Access to all other residences and businesses will remain unchanged.

#### What to expect during these works?

Nearby businesses and residents should expect intermittent, medium-level construction noise during the day.

The water supply may be temporarily impacted when the new water main is connected. Unitywater will inform residents and businesses of any temporary changes to supply.
