

**Update - Dulong Road, Dulong**  
Road Reseal and Rehabilitation Program**Update summary**

Council is currently undertaking reconstruction works on Dulong Road. The project is divided into stages.

1. Stage 1 - Completed
2. Stages 2, 3 and 4 to re-commenc on 9th January 2024.

**Traffic management Stage 2**

To accomplish the remaining stages in a safe and timely manner it will be necessary to **close** Dulong Road between Phillips Road and Dulong School Road to **all traffic** between the hours of **6-30pm & 6-30am**, residents of the described section are exempted.

Emergency services will have right of way. A traffic management plan is in place and traffic must follow all signage instructions.

**Pedestrian Access**

Pedestrian access will be facilitated throughout the duration of the works however due to the work processes, there will be times when vehicular access may not be possible.

**Works process**

The work is as follows:

- Removal of existing pavement
- Reconstruction with stabilised pavement
- Construction of kerb and channel
- Resurfacing

*Any Inclement weather will impact upon our programmed timeline.*

Road reconstruction entails the use of heavy plant and machinery with considerable truck movements. Significant noise from machinery and disruption to usual traffic flow is likely to be experienced.

Council apologises for any inconvenience and assures you that every attempt is made to minimise disruptions while works are being completed.

**A note from your local councillor**

I am pleased to see these works occur to ensure safe transit and connectivity of our communities. However, I appreciate there will be some inconvenience for residents for a period of time. The project team are keen to complete these works in a timely manner and do their best to work with the community during construction.
