Stringybark Road Pedestrian and Cycle Bridge – Sippy Downs



Late February and March works



Day works - 6am to 6pm (Monday to Friday).

Night works – 7pm to 5am – various dates in late February and March

*all works are subject to weather and construction material/equipment availability.

Some changes to traffic conditions including detours and lane closures as required.
Reduced speed limits in construction zones.

Project update

March will see the completion of all construction activity for both the new pedestrian and cycle bridge and upgrades to the existing vehicle bridge on Stringybark Road (weather permitting).

The new pedestrian and cycle bridge is open and has been enthusiastically embraced for use by our community. The new \$11.8 million bridge is proudly supported by the Queensland Government's Cycle Network Local Government Grants program and Sunshine Coast Council.

As the project nears completion some night works are required and have been scheduled for late February and early March (weather permitting).

For safety reasons these works will require some temporary changes to traffic conditions on Stringybark Road and the Sunshine Motorway including detours and lane closures. More detailed information has been provided in this notification. Please allow extra travel time during these works or use alternative routes as required. We thank you for your patience and cooperation.

Late February and March construction activity

Day works:

- landscape completion
- lighting commissioning
- line marking
- road reconfiguration
- construction compound demobilised and handback to site owners

Night works include:

- installation of steel bridge barriers on the existing vehicle bridge
- removal of scaffolding on pedestrian and cycle bridge
- installation of new concrete road barriers on the Sunshine Motorway
- reinstatement of wire rope barriers on the Sunshine Motorway

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Temporary changes to traffic conditions will continue on Stringybark Road and the Sunshine Motorway.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

The temporary changes to traffic conditions include:

**Night works – Tuesday 25 February to Thursday 13
March (intermittent nights) 7pm – 5am
Stringybark Road and Sunshine Motorway**

Works include removal of existing bridge barriers, installation of new bridge barriers, removal of scaffolding and construction fencing.

Due to safety reasons, traffic changes will be in place on Stringybark Road and the Sunshine Motorway including detours and single lane closures as required.

Signage will communicate the changed traffic conditions to motorists with traffic control in place where required.

These night works are not expected to create high level noise and have been scheduled at night to minimise peak day time traffic congestion, particularly during peak school drop off and pick up times.

Reduced speed limits in construction zones

Reduced speed limits on Stringybark Road and the Sunshine Motorway will continue to apply during construction activity. Speed cameras remain with infringement notices issued to motorists not driving to the changed conditions.

Reinstatement of normal speed limits post

construction Once all construction is complete normal speed limits will be reinstated.
