Construction overview

With major roadworks nearing completion on the new Mayes Canal Bridge, asphalt (bitumen) works are scheduled this Sunday 2 and Monday 3 July. To keep traffic flowing along busy Brisbane Road during the day, these works must be undertaken at night.

Vehicle access over the bridge will remain available each evening with one lane of traffic operating in each direction.

These works have been scheduled to take place on the quieter nights of the week to minimise inconvenience to our community.

Please see the map on page 2 of this notification for further details and allow an extra 5 minutes of travel time during these works.

NB: These works are heavily weather dependent. In the case of rain, works will be postponed, most likely to the next available fine evening/s.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Two way traffic flow (one lane in each direction) will be maintained across the bridge each evening.

Traffic control will be in place for our community's safety.

Normal public transport services will continue to operate.

Once night works are complete the bridge's traffic lanes will move slightly closer to the Bowls Club side of Brisbane Road. This will allow adequate space for construction activity to safely continue on the River Esplanade and Bindaree Crescent side of the bridge.

What to expect during these works?

The construction team will make every effort to minimise impacts to the community however nearby residents and businesses can expect intermittent construction noise including the operation of heavy machinery and large vehicles each evening.

For residents sensitive to sound and/or the smell of asphalt, please consider closing blinds and windows and using fans or air conditioning where possible.

Please allow an extra 5 minutes of travel time when travelling to destinations in/near the construction zone.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.
