About these works

As part of the power infrastructure improvements associated with the Brisbane Road Upgrade, the contractor will be undertaking urgent works tomorrow evening, Thursday 14 October from 6pm to 6am.

These works will involve relocating electrical conduits underneath and across Brisbane Road near Kapala Street, Mooloolaba.

Access will remain available to local homes and businesses. Traffic flow will be maintained along Brisbane Road.

What to expect during these works?

The road surface will be cut and a trench dug across Brisbane Road. A sucker truck will vacuum material out of the trench. Electrical conduits will be installed and the trench backfilled.

Nearby residents and businesses can expect intermittent, medium level noise including the operation of heavy machinery. Where possible noisier works will be undertaken prior to midnight.

Temporary alternative pedestrian pathways will be in place as required.

No power outages are expected.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Traffic flow will be retained along Brisbane Road and Kapala Street. Traffic control will be in attendance.

The TransLink bus stops on Brisbane Road adjacent to the Mooloolaba Bowls Club and Mooloolaba Central Motel (stops #301698 and #301699 – Routes 600, 611 and 615) will remain operational.
