Project overview

Sunshine Coast Council is planning to make the Sugar Road and Maud Street travel corridor (from Bungama Street to Wises Road), safer and more efficient for all users. The ultimate project will be delivered across multiple stages and include:

- new, separated pathways for walking and riding
- new signalised and raised priority crossings at key intersections
- widening Sugar Road and Maud Street from two to four lanes
- making the area greener and more comfortable and enjoyable for walking and riding
- providing a transport corridor that supports a vibrant, connected and future-ready Maroochydore.

Ongoing early works

Council is undertaking a range of interim and early works ahead of the longer-term final design and construction of the new transport corridor.

Since late 2025, line marking changes, footpath and cycle ramp improvements and underground service works have been taking place. The next phase of works involves geotechnical investigations.

Geotechnical investigations – night works

Geotechnical works are required for most construction projects. Investigations are carried out by experienced geotechnical engineers using specialist equipment and machinery to understand existing ground conditions to inform design and construction requirements.

To help progress the detailed design of the project, geotechnical works will take place next week from the Aerodrome Road-Maud Street intersection to Sugar-Wises Roads Roundabout (weather permitting).

For safety reasons these works must be undertaken at night as some investigations are required under road or footpath surfaces.

Sugar Road and Maud Street will remain open to two-way traffic and access will remain available to local residences and businesses. Traffic control will be in operation as required.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

What to expect during this work

A series of boreholes will be excavated in various locations along Sugar Road and Maud Street with the aid of mini drill rig vehicles. At the completion of works, all areas will be patched.

Intermittent, low-medium level noise impacts can be expected with geotechnical workers, machinery, and vehicles on site.
