A note from your local councillor - Cr Taylor Bunnag

Communities right across Division 8 will benefit from projects that will come to life because of this budget.

For residents in the Coolum and Mount Coolum area, planning is continuing for the extension of both Suncoast Beach Drive and South Coolum Road. These are significant and long-awaited projects, decades in the making, that will complement the State Government's planned south-facing ramps on the Sunshine Motorway.

Planning is also underway for the Duporth Avenue streetscape in Maroochydore, with an aim to integrate seamlessly with the Ocean Street and First Avenue streetscape upgrades, creating a cohesive and improved urban environment.

In Pacific Paradise, pathway connectivity is a focus with a new pathway down Karome Street to link with the local school. This pathway project forms part of a broader effort across our division to create safer pedestrian and active transport connections.

One of the most exciting projects is the upgrade of Felix Parry Park into a true district-level park near the Marcoola Surf Club. The project is currently in the final consultation phase to ensure the design meets community expectations, with construction now funded.
