DESIGN OBJECTIVES

- Traffic**
 - Create Maleny Village Precinct to enhance pedestrian safety and traditional character
 - Maintain existing through traffic
 - Improve traffic flow and safety at intersection of Teak and Maple Streets
 - Introduce passive traffic calming elements
- On Street Parking**
 - Replace concrete wheel stops with kerb extensions
 - Retain reverse in parking at an easier angle
- Off Street Parking**
 - Rationalise and improve carparks off laneways
 - Establish and improve pedestrian linkages
 - Improve signage to carparks for visitors
- Community Meeting Places**
 - Develop a community heart at the central crossing and Community Hall
 - Develop a series of community spaces at new build outs and in existing parks
- Entries**
 - Enhance sense of entry to create Maleny Village Precinct
 - Create entry statements and plantings
 - Improve information signage at entries
- Footpaths**
 - New paving and street furniture
 - Footpath build-outs for alfresco dining, social spaces and markets
 - Underground power and introduce street trees
- Pedestrian Safety**
 - Introduce a new crossing at Cooke Park to enhance pedestrian movement
 - Improve pedestrian permeability and linkages
 - Improve access for the disabled and elderly
- Character**
 - Maintain traditional service town character
 - Introduce local rural themes
 - Create Maleny Village Precinct
