Construction overview

Construction of Stages 2 and 3 of the Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade project is nearing completion.

Subject to weather conditions, council and the construction contractor will have all major roadworks completed by the end of this month (July) including the traffic lanes across the new Mayes Canal bridge.

The new traffic lanes and new pedestrian and cyclist shared pathway on the western side (Bowls Club side) of the bridge are expected to open by week commencing Monday 10 July. The new feature timber boardwalk on the eastern side ('The Wharf' side) of the bridge is expected to open by late August. This element of the project has been delayed due to timber supply shortages.

Minor landscaping and rectification works will continue throughout July and August 2023 in all areas. These works are not expected to have any major impact on our community.

The completed project will deliver a much 'greener' Brisbane Road. It will include over 200 new trees and over 8800 plants as part of landscaping in the project area.

Night works end July (TBC)

The final asphalt (bitumen) layer and line marking on Mayes Canal Bridge will take place at the end of this month (July). To minimise inconvenience to businesses and residents and keep traffic flowing along busy Brisbane Road these works must be undertaken at night. It is estimated that this work will be undertaken over two nights only.

Vehicle access over the bridge will remain available on these evenings with one lane of traffic operating in each direction.

We will issue another construction notification closer to the date of the confirmed night works.

NB: These works are heavily weather dependent. In the case of rain, works will be postponed, most likely to the next available fine evening/s dependent on sub-contractor availability.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Traffic control will be in place as required during all construction works for our community's safety. Normal public transport services will continue to operate.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

What to expect during these works?

The construction team will make every effort to minimise impacts to the community however nearby residents and businesses can expect intermittent construction noise including the operation of heavy machinery and large vehicles.
