Mike,

As part of the development of Council's LGIP, I am required to provide a statement that Sunshine Coast Council goes about its transport planning for major infrastructure in general consultation with the Department of Transport and Main Roads, sufficient to satisfy sound integration of transport network planning.

I believe that this is captured in the following ways:-

1. Joint development of the Sunshine Coast Integrated Multi-Modal Model (SCIMMM).
2. Quarterly meetings with senior TMR and Council officers discussing network integration.
3. Quarterly meetings with State Government agencies held in Brisbane, with a focus on transport and again looking to work together to build joint outcomes.
4. Scheduled meetings to discuss network planning covering the major centres of Maroochydore, Caloundra, Mooloolaba, Birtinya, Sippy Downs & Nambour.
5. TMR carrying out active consultation with Council's Transport planners to capture issues of mutual importance, including integration of our networks.
