About these works

As part of the Brisbane Road upgrade, underground and overhead power infrastructure is being improved. This includes the installation of underground conduits to house Energex electricity cables.

A large number of these conduits is located in the footpath area adjacent to 22 Brisbane Road, Mooloolaba.

From Tuesday 19 October until approximately Thursday 21 October, between 7am and 5pm, construction workers will be on site installing the conduits. No construction will take place at night.

We ask you to please brief all residents/tenants regarding these works.

What to expect during these works?

For safety reasons a fenced construction zone will be in place 24/7. It will likely extend into the private property boundary.

To install the conduits construction crews must cut the footpath and driveway surfaces and dig a trench. Once the conduits are installed the trench will be backfilled. A temporary asphalt (bitumen) surface will be applied over the area until a new permanent footpath is constructed later this year.

Nearby residents and businesses can expect intermittent, medium level noise, vibration and the operation of machinery including a concrete saw, excavator and compacting equipment.

Concrete trucks and other construction vehicles will be operating.

No power outages are expected.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions – day and night

Pedestrian and vehicle access will remain to the property.

Stop and go traffic control will be in place as required to assist machinery and construction vehicles to access the construction zone from/to Brisbane Road.

For safety reasons the adjacent on street parking bay on Brisbane Road will be temporarily unavailable.

The onsite construction contractor will liaise directly with residents about these works as required.

Every effort will be made to reduce the level of inconvenience to residents and their visitors.
