A note from your local councillor - Cr Jenny Broderick

I'm thrilled to share some of the key highlights from this year's Division 1 budget.

This budget is all about delivering practical outcomes right across Division 1, ensuring both our coastal and hinterland communities can continue to thrive as they grow.

I'm especially excited about the projects funded through Council's 2026–27 Minor Works Program, focused on local improvements that make a genuine difference in day-to-day lives.

A standout investment is Stage 1 of a new \$320,000 pump track in Glasshouse Country, creating an active and inclusive space for young people and families.

I'm also pleased to confirm that \$115,000 has been allocated for Stage 1 of the long-awaited Peachester Park. This marks an important milestone for a growing hinterland community that deserves quality recreational spaces close to home.

At Baringa, funding for a new shelter at the dog park will improve comfort and usability year-round for residents and their pets. We're also continuing to invest in essential pathway connections, helping people move safely between schools, parks and local destinations.

This budget reflects the voices of our community and my commitment to keeping Division 1 a great place to live – from the coast to the hinterland.
