Construction overview

Major road works are continuing for Stages 2 and 3 of the Brisbane Road Upgrade.

To assist with managing traffic flow throughout the upcoming school holiday period, an additional temporary traffic lane will be operating on Hancock Street from today, Friday 24 June to Sunday 17 July at various peak traffic times. Please refer to the following temporary changes to traffic conditions for details of days and times.

This change is in response to requests from local businesses and residents.

The construction team is doing everything possible to make up lost construction time caused by the recent prolonged period of wet weather.

These additional Hancock Street lane opening changes will impact construction progress and the reopening date of the Brisbane Road/Walan Street/Hancock Street intersection.

The project team will advise of the revised intersection reopening dates after the holiday period and following assessment of construction progress.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Temporary northbound lane, Hancock Street – from Friday 24 June to Sunday 17 July (various times)

- Sunday to Thursday
 - OPEN: 6.30am to 7.30pm
 - CLOSED: 7.30pm to 6.30am
- Friday to Saturday
 - OPEN: 6.30am to 9.30pm
 - CLOSED: 9.30pm to 6.30am

The temporary lane will permit through traffic only (no left or right turn onto Brisbane Road). This will assist with traffic movement along Parkyn Parade and River Esplanade, as well as Mooloolaba traffic in general.

Temporary traffic signals and additional signage will be in operation when Hancock Street is open.

After the holidays, the temporary lane will revert to peak weekend periods only – from 12 noon Friday, to Sunday evening, until the Brisbane Road/Hancock Street intersection reopens.

What to expect during these works?

The current works are major construction works with large machinery operating. Intermittent medium-high level noise is to be expected.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

Dust mitigation measures, including dust monitors are in place. Alternative footpaths are in place.

Detour signage has been erected to communicate traffic changes to motorists.

All businesses in the construction areas on Brisbane Road, Hancock Street, Kapala Street, Taroola Avenue, First Avenue and Walan Street, along with businesses along Mooloolaba Esplanade and Parkyn Parade remain OPEN during these works. Please continue to support local businesses during the construction period.

Bus services are operating with alternative routes in place as required. Signage has been erected to help redirect passengers.

Motorists are advised to obey reduced speed limits, follow directional signage and importantly, allow extra travel time.
