

What to expect cont.

Electricity and telecommunications services will be maintained. Minimal noise impacts are expected.

For community safety, some changes to pedestrian movements will be required with alternative pathways and signage in place as required.

At times stop and go traffic and partial lane closures may be required for short periods with traffic control in place. Speed limits will be reduced to 40km/hr around the works area. Delays to travel times are expected to be minimal.
