Construction Notification

In preparation for upgrades to the Bowman Road and Gosling Street intersection, Council will soon start works on the relocation of overhead powerlines in the area.

The relocation of Energex powerlines will be undertaken in two stages.

Works overview

Stage 1

Council's electrical contractor, Trafflec, will install new underground electrical conduits and pits. Stage 1 works are expected to start on 28 July and be completed by August (weather and site conditions permitting).

Stage 2

Energex will relocate existing overhead lines and power poles. Some existing overhead lines will move to underground as part of this relocation. Timing for Stage 2 works, as well as any impacts to power supply will be confirmed by Energex following completion of Stage 1 works. See the diagram below for the location of these works.



What to expect during Stage 1

Stage 1 works will take place during the day, between the hours of 6.30am and 5.30pm, Monday to Friday and are not expected to have any major impacts to our community.





What to expect cont.

Electricity and telecommunications services will be maintained. Minimal noise impacts are expected.

For community safety, some changes to pedestrian movements will be required with alternative pathways and signage in place as required.

At times stop and go traffic and partial lane closures may be required for short periods with traffic control in place. Speed limits will be reduced to 40km/hr around the works area. Delays to travel times are expected to be minimal.
