Solutions New and updated temporary changes to traffic conditions.

Night works Sunday 28 August to Thursday 8 September **NEW** Sunday 11 September – Monday 12 September (inclusive)

September 2022 to December 2022 (estimated dates only, all works weather and site

conditions dependent)

Brisbane Road, Tarcoola Avenue, Walan Street and Hancock Street Mooloolaba

Vehicle, pedestrian, cyclist and marine traffic control

Night works continue this week to enable Brisbane Road traffic to be moved to the two new traffic lanes on the western side of the road, while construction of the two new eastern lanes takes place.

Due to the availability of asphalt (bitumen) materials, two additional evenings of nightworks must now take place on **Sunday 11 September and Monday 12 September** (inclusive).

The Brisbane Road/Walan Street/Hancock Street intersection reopening remains on track for **Wednesday 14 September**.

The Tarcoola Avenue full road opening remains on track for **Monday 19 September.**

All works and dates are weather dependent.

Temporary changes to vehicle and marine traffic conditions

Night works: Hancock Street, Brisbane Road, Tarcoola Avenue

Wednesday 7 September to Monday 12 September (intermittent evenings, <u>excluding</u> Friday and Saturday evenings)

Wednesday 7 September (inclusive) Brisbane Road and Tarcoola Avenue section, between Tarcoola Avenue and Club Mooloolaba Bowls Club (refer Figure 1)

Asphalt (bitumen) works will take place. This will involve the first layer of asphalt being applied to the road surface.

Thursday 8 September plus Sunday 11 – Monday 12 September: Brisbane Road/Hancock Street intersection and Brisbane Road/Tarcoola Avenue section, between Tarcoola Avenue and Club Mooloolaba Bowls Club

Asphalt (bitumen) works will take place at these locations.

A final layer of asphalt will be applied to the full Stages 2 and 3 area at the completion of all road works. This will be followed by line marking. We will advise the community in advance of these works.

Mayes Canal Bridge construction

Week commencing Monday 19 September to mid October 2022 – piling works

The dates of these works have changed slightly due to the availability of construction materials.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

Reinforced concrete columns (piles) will be drilled into rock beneath Mayes Canal. The piles are up to 14.5 metres long and constructed onsite, where thick-walled metal tubes are hammered into the ground, hollowed out, and then reinforced with steel and concrete.

Large cranes, piling rigs and heavy machinery will be in operation with marine and vehicle traffic control in place as required.

What to expect during these works?

Roadworks

While most construction is taking place during the day, some night works are required to ensure vehicle traffic can continue to operate on busy Brisbane Road and surrounding streets during the day.

For safety reasons, nightworks require temporary lighting and vehicles fitted with reversing beepers.

During asphalt works large vehicles and heavy equipment will be in operation.

Motorists are advised to obey reduced speed limits, follow directional signage and the instructions of traffic control and/or Queensland Police.

Detour signage has been erected to communicate traffic changes to motorists and pedestrians.

Please allow extra travel time during construction periods and continue to support local businesses wherever possible.

Environmental and traffic considerations

All construction is being performed with the relevant Environmental Management Plans and Traffic Management Plans in place.
