Did you know?

The 1997 Loo with a View refurbishment was coordinated by Maroochy Shire Council and designed by Clare Design (architects Kerry and Lindsay Clare), John Mongard Landscape Architects, and Maunsell.

Nine public art pieces were also introduced as part of the foreshore improvements.

- Community engagement between 2012-2015
- 82% support for the draft master plan
 - 3000+ participants
- x4 community public event consultation days
 - 600+ attendees to public event days
 - x2 stakeholder workshops
 - 1 on 1 stakeholder meetings
- 1300+ survey responses received
- 150 responses from children of local schools
