Project summary

The Coastal Pathway at Alex Bluff Foreshore Park is being upgraded to improve accessibility, safety and amenity along the Coastal Pathway network.

The existing 1.8-metre-wide path will be renewed and widened to a 3.5-metre shared pathway, providing a safer and more enjoyable experience for all users.

Works in progress

Council, in partnership with SGQ Pty Ltd as the principal contractor for the project, are progressing well despite some unforeseen delays incurred in March and wet weather impacts.

This has resulted in a revised date on completing Beach Access 166 and the Bluff Viewing area, however we are pleased to share that we will be opening this section in the coming weeks (mid May - weather permitting).

The boardwalk section and Mooloolaba section of the works continue to progress well.

Beach Access 164 and 165 at 'the corner' remain open for access to Alex Beach. Beach Access 168 remains open for access to Mooloolaba Beach.

Traffic and pedestrian management

A signed detour changing the pedestrian route will soon be implemented to allow for the next stage of construction to occur safely.

Access on the coastal side of Alexandra Parade will remain open between Alex Surf Club and the Mooloolaba Boardwalk

There will be temporary adjustments to the pedestrian path, so please follow the detour signs.

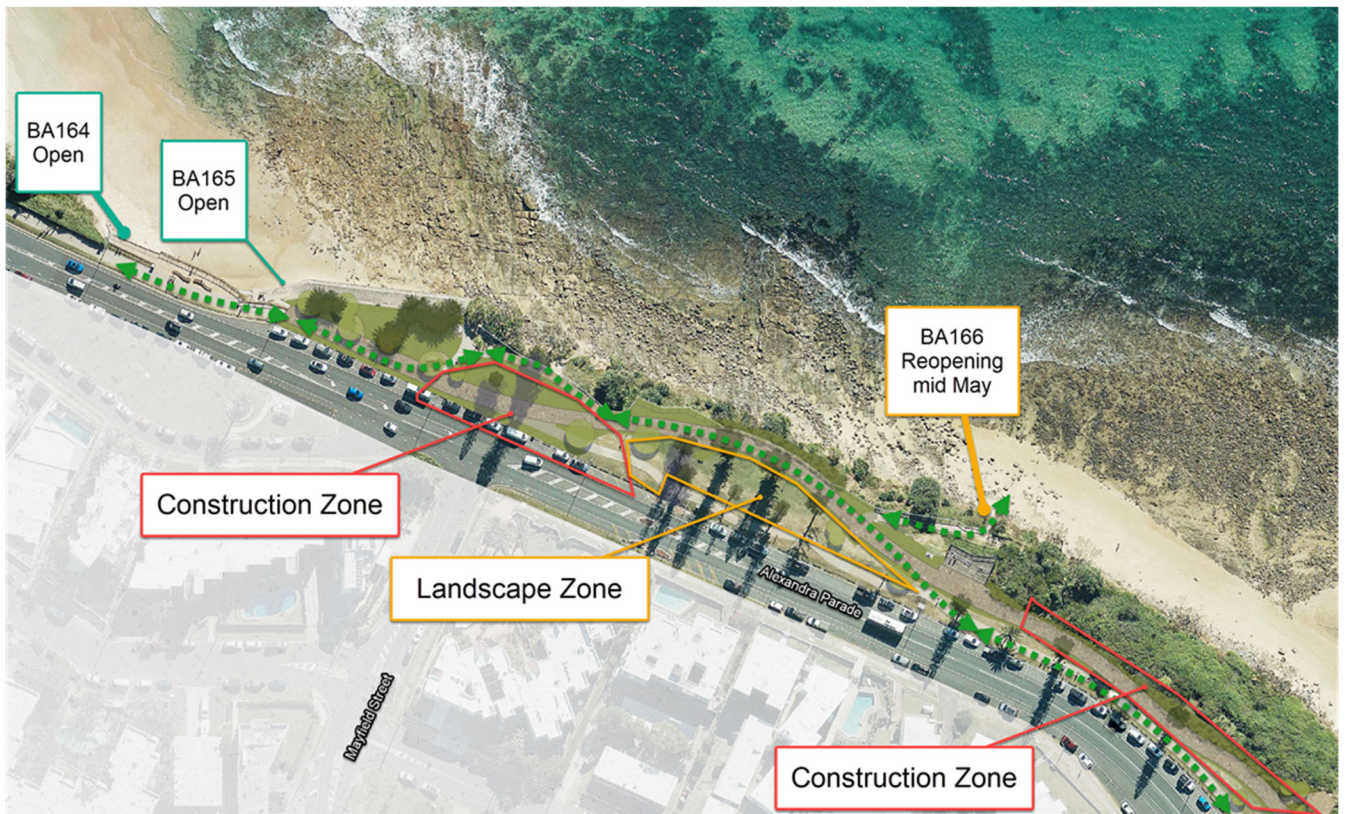
What to expect

Noisy works are continuing along with truck and construction equipment. The majority of below ground level works have been completed. Concrete pathway and landscaping works are the main tasks currently being undertaken.

We are working to 'shrink' the construction site as works progress. It's anticipated some sections of construction fencing will start to be removed next month as works are completed and also open up landscaped areas for our community to use.

Council thanks the residents and road users for your understanding and continued patience during construction and apologises for the inconvenience this may cause.
