Some Saturday works between 7am – 1pm



Temporary changes to traffic conditions as required for construction machinery access, including crane

Construction overview

This month will see final construction, along with the overall finishing touches taking place in the Northern Parkland.

Weather permitting, the new parkland will open in time for the Queensland School Holidays.

Details of June works

Zone B Parkland

- Ongoing Ocean View Deck construction
- Pandanus Tower playground – last 'pod' installation, completion of soft fall areas and shade sail installation
- Final 'street furniture' such as seating and bins
- Wayfinding signage installation
- Pathway and public footpath works including: feature paving, new tactiles and handrail works near the taxi rank, footpath sealing, stepping stones in open grassed area
- Low level fencing installed adjacent to the public footpath – for safety and to protect vegetation from people 'short-cutting' through the gardens
- Construction site fence removal and site clean-up (on completion of all other works)

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Following the successful installation of the new Pandanus playground tower frames, and one play pod last month, the final pod will be installed on Monday 6 June.

To safely undertake these works, approximately 50 metres of the southbound lane of Mooloolaba Esplanade, opposite the Venning Street intersection, will be temporarily closed to motorists. The northbound lane will remain open.

Signage and detours will be in place with normal traffic conditions resuming each evening. The taxi rank will remain open under traffic control.

Access to the Mooloolaba Esplanade, including the Beach Terrace car park will remain open via Smith Street and First Avenue (see map for more information)

Alternative pedestrian pathways will be in place as required.

Pedestrian access will remain available to all businesses and residences
