Construction update

We would like to thank the community, particularly Mooloolaba residents and businesses for your patience and cooperation regarding construction in 2021.

As residents, visitors and businesses prepare to enjoy the peak holiday and trading period, construction will cease from Friday 24 December 2021 to Sunday 9 January 2022 (inclusive). Construction will recommence on Monday 10 January 2022.

During the construction break there will be no changes to traffic conditions. All roads and pedestrian pathways will be fully operational.

January 2022 works including night works

January will see a wide range of construction activities taking place over multiple areas.

Construction will be a combination of day and night works to ensure construction progresses as safely and efficiently as possible.

Activity will include upgrades to stormwater, telecommunications (Telstra), and mains water (Unitywater) services along with continuing construction of the new Mayes Canal bridge.

What to expect during these works?

10 January to 29 January. 6am – 6pm. Stormwater works, Brisbane Road. A large stormwater chamber will be constructed in the road verge area, adjacent to the Mooloolaba Bowls Club.

14 January to 18 January. 6am – 6pm. Mayes Canal Bridge construction, Brisbane Road.

Cranes will be positioned in the parkland on the banks on both sides of Mayes Canal (Bindaree Crescent and River Esplanade).

The cranes will lift large concrete beams onto the new bridge foundations. The beams will be secured in place in preparation for construction of the new bridge road surface.

19 January to 21 January. 6pm – 6am (Night works). Telstra telecommunication works, Brisbane Road.

Telstra will be switching services from the old to the new network. Some minor interruptions to services can be expected between midnight and 6am on these nights.

January 2022 various dates. 6am – 6am (Day and night works) Unitywater mains water works, Brisbane Road, Foote Street, Tarcoola Avenue and River Esplanade.

Unitywater will be installing new water main pipes under the road surface and connecting the mains water supply to the new pipes.

Unitywater will make direct contact with residents and businesses about these works, including information about any temporary interruptions to water supply.

Construction equipment and access

All January works will require the use of large machinery including cranes, tunnel boring machines and trucks.

Intermittent low-medium level noise can be expected including the use of vehicles with reversing beepers and whistles to direct the operation of trucks and cranes.

Night works will have temporary lighting in place. This is a safety requirement.

Access to businesses and residences will remain available. In some cases, alternative footpaths will be in place.

Safety zones will apply around the construction areas.

The construction team will make every effort to minimise construction impacts to the community during these works.

Changes to traffic conditions

Traffic flow will be maintained with some temporary changes to traffic conditions during the day and night as required.

There will be no road detours during January however some temporary lane closures may be in place during night works for safety reasons.
