### About these works

Council is continuing to upgrade underground infrastructure in Caloundra, including telecommunications.

Telecommunications infrastructure includes fibre-ready pit and pipe infrastructure to accommodate modern fixed and mobile telecommunications services, including NBN, broadband, Telstra, Optus and other telecommunications network providers.

Council's contractor, Ventia, will be installing new conduits and relocating existing telecommunications cables, in stages, over the coming months at various locations along Oval Avenue, Third Avenue, Olm Street, Arthur Street and Second Avenue in Caloundra (weather and site conditions permitting).

The next stages of works will take place from mid-June to late-July. Please refer to the map on page 2 for the location of these works.

### What to expect

Works will primarily involve under-boring which is making small holes and horizontal tunnels underneath footpaths, driveway crossovers, road surface and verges using specialised machinery drills.

Intermittent noise can be expected throughout the day including contractors on site and machinery and vehicles operating including small excavators, small trucks, boring equipment and vacuum trucks. All noise will be within permissible noise limits under the Environmental Protection Act.

Upon completion of these works any disturbed areas will be rectified.

Should any temporary service outages be expected, the relevant telecommunications network provider will make advance, direct contact with those affected residents or businesses.

Access will remain available to the Caloundra Shopping Centre with small areas of the centre's car parks temporarily unavailable for safety reasons during works.

### Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Access will remain available to homes and businesses. For safety reasons temporary changes to traffic conditions may be required at times, with traffic control in operation. Please observe signage and/or the instructions of traffic controllers.

Some on-street and private parking areas may be inaccessible for temporary periods. The onsite team will liaise directly with relevant residents and businesses as required.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.
