## Kings Beach saltwater pool resurfacing

### Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to the continual upgrade and improvement of its recreational facilities within our region. As part of this commitment, we're undertaking important upgrade works at the Kings Beach saltwater pool.

The internal surface of the pool has significantly deteriorated and now requires a full renewal. To complete the upgrade, the pool will be emptied, the existing surface removed, and a brand-new surface installed. The pool will be closed to the public during construction works, which will require the use of machinery, including hammer drilling.

Works will improve safety and user experience, reduce ongoing maintenance and repair costs and ensure the pool is protected for many years to come.

### Start date

Construction is scheduled to start on Monday 20 April and is expected to be completed by 30 June 2026, subject to weather and site conditions. (See Figure 1 for location of works.)

### Property access and parking

We will make every effort to minimise construction impacts. The contractor will require vehicle access to the pool via the access road shown in Figure 1. The connecting pathway at the western entrance to the pool will be unavailable during construction.

### Traffic management

Your safety – and the safety of our construction crews – is our top priority. Traffic management measures will be in place throughout construction as required. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we deliver these important improvements to one of Caloundra's favourite coastal spots.
