### Construction overview

The next few weeks will see the completion of all major road works for Stages 2 and 3 of the Brisbane Road Upgrade, including the Mayes Canal Bridge.

Final line marking and asphalt (bitumen) works will also take place across the whole project area.

To minimise inconvenience to our community including local events such as the Sunshine Coast Marathon and Brisbane's Royal Queensland Show Holiday (metro Brisbane only), line marking and asphalt works have been scheduled to take place at night.

These works are heavily weather dependent. Should rain be forecast works will be postponed to a later date.

### Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Two way traffic flow (one lane each way) will be maintained along Brisbane Road, Mayes Canal Bridge and surrounding streets each evening.

Pedestrian access to residences and businesses will be maintained.

On street parking in some areas may be temporarily unavailable during these works.

Bus services and stops will operate as usual.

Where required, traffic control will help redirect motorists and pedestrians.

### What to expect during these works?

The construction team will make every effort to minimise impacts to the community however nearby residents and businesses can expect some intermittent construction noise each evening.

Line marking works are expected to generate low noise impacts.

Asphalt works on the Mayes Canal Bridge will require the use of heavy machinery and vehicles. Medium level noise impacts are expected.

For residents sensitive to the smell of asphalt, please consider closing blinds and windows and using fans or air conditioning where possible.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

Please allow an extra 5-10 minutes of travel time when travelling to destinations in/near the construction zone.
