
# **Caloundra Transport Corridor Upgrade February 2025 Update**

#### **Works overview**

As part of the project's ongoing early works, koala surveys will take place in and around the Caloundra Transport Corridor Upgrade's (CTCU) 1.6 kilometre route throughout February.

Previous surveys within the area have shown no evidence of koalas, however surveys like this form part of the ongoing preparation works ahead of the project's major construction period.

### What to expect during these works

Qualified, specialist consultants from the University of the Sunshine Coast will be coordinating the survey.

A combination of detection methods will be used including field officers, specialist acoustic equipment and koala detection dogs. The survey works are not expected to have any significant impact on our community.

#### Where to from here

The final design for the overall corridor is expected to be finalised early this year (2025).

Council and the Department of Transport and Main Roads look forward to sharing this with our Stakeholder Interest Group and community in the coming months.

Construction for Section One is planned to start in 2025, once a construction contractor has been appointed.
