Stage One update

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to enhancing sport and recreation spaces across our region.

Works are progressing well on major upgrades to Kawana Aquatic Centre, part of our region's thriving sporting heart.

Stage One of the upgrade is on track for completion in early 2024, weather and site conditions permitting.

The first stage includes a new indoor program pool, along with improved structures, operating equipment, and the demolition of the existing indoor pool.

Stage Two update

Council has now advertised the tender for Stage Two construction.

Stage Two works will include a new entry building, public amenities and changerooms, a refurbished kiosk, and improved car parking.

The centre remains fully operational during all works for both stages.

We thank patrons and surrounding businesses for your patience and understanding as we maintain and upgrade this much-loved community facility.
