A note from your local councillor - Cr Ted Hungerford

Budget 2026–27 has a strong focus on getting the basics right while planning responsibly for the future.

From the hinterland to the coast, residents consistently tell me the same things matter most – safe roads, well-maintained parks and reserves, and communities that feel connected and looked after. The everyday details like paths, playgrounds and local infrastructure allow us all to enjoy our region.

A significant project I'm particularly pleased to see included is the Petrie Creek Road shoulder widening, from Paynters Creek Road to Celestine Place in Rosemount. With \$4 million allocated, this is a practical and important upgrade that will improve safety and connectivity along a busy section of road, creating safer conditions for everyone who uses it.

Just like our residents, Council is facing a tough financial environment. This has meant some hard decisions, and we are very conscious that many households across the Sunshine Coast are feeling the strain of cost-of-living pressures.

Overall, this budget reflects a sensible approach – delivering what our community needs today while making sure Council remains financially sustainable for the years ahead.
