## About these works

As part of construction of the new four lane bridge over Mayes Canal, large vehicles and specialist construction machinery including cranes and piling rigs are being used.

In the early hours of Monday to Thursday next week, these cranes and piling rigs will be removed from the construction site via Brisbane Road.

State Government regulations dictate the movements of oversize vehicles on the Queensland road network.

For safety reasons and to minimise impacts to the community including motorists along Brisbane Road, oversize vehicles and machinery must be moved early in the morning.

Access will remain available for local residents and businesses.

## What to expect during these works?

Intermittent noise can be expected, including large trucks travelling to/from Brisbane Road and vehicles reversing into the construction site.

Vehicle reversing beepers will be in use in accordance with workplace health and safety regulations.

Construction workers will be present, helping to load the cranes and piling rigs onto trucks. Traffic control will be in operation.
