Notice to businesses, residents and motorists Stormwater works, intersection of Muraban St and Smith St 29 October 2020, weather and site conditions permitting

New stormwater will be installed at the intersection of Muraban and Smith streets, Mooloolaba.

As part of the upgrade the Muraban and Smith streets intersection will be temporarily closed to vehicle traffic on Thursday, 29 October between 6.30am and 6pm, weather and site conditions permitting.

Local access for Muraban Street residents and businesses is recommended via First Avenue/ First Lane.

Access to driveways along Muraban Street will remain.

Signage and traffic controllers will be present during the closure.

What we are doing during these works

These works will include cutting the road surface, digging trenches and installing new stormwater pipes.

What to expect during these works?


Residents and nearby businesses should expect intermittent, low-medium level noise impacts.

Reduced speed limits and changes to traffic conditions will be in place.

Increased traffic volumes are expected in First Avenue and Muraban Street.

Signage and traffic controllers will be present during the works.
