Pathway Improvements – Meridan Street and Nicklin Way, Bokarina

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to improving and maintaining pathway networks across our region.

In partnership with the Queensland Government, Council will be widening footpaths around Kawana Waters State College.

A 300m long section of existing 1.2m footpath will be widened to 2m to allow for the growing volume of pathway users.

The upgraded path will extend from Meridan Street at Sportsmans Parade to 382 Nicklin Way (Beaumont Tiles), Bokarina.

Start date

Works have been timed with the school break. Works are planned to commence week beginning Monday 8 January 2024 and are expected to take two weeks, weather permitting.

Property access

Construction crews will contact businesses prior to starting any works which may affect property access.

Traffic management

Traffic management measures will be in place throughout construction to ensure the safety of all road users. The footpath will be closed during reconstruction.
