Brisbane Road Upgrade

Stages 2 and 3

Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade

-  Temporary changes to traffic conditions – including road closures and detours
-  Various time periods, at different locations between 27 April to late November 2022
-  Kapala Street, Tarcoola Avenue, First Avenue, Walan Street, Mooloolaba
-  Traffic control in attendance

Construction overview

The eastern side of Brisbane Road from Hancock Street and Walan Street to Mayes Canal Bridge is being upgraded from early April to late November 2022.

These works include widening Brisbane Road to accommodate two new traffic lanes, kerb and channel construction, mains water and stormwater upgrades, new footpaths and electrical works.

To accommodate these works some temporary changes to traffic conditions are required. These include detours and full or partial closures along Kapala Street, Tarcoola Avenue and Brisbane Road-First Avenue intersection.

Vehicle and pedestrian access remains available to all residences and businesses including:

- **Club Mooloolaba Bowls Club** - via Tarcoola Avenue into Kapala Street
- **Mooloolaba Junction Convenience Centre** - via Tarcoola Avenue into Kapala Street
- **ParkNGo Mooloolaba Central Car Park and businesses located between First Avenue and Walan Street** - via Brisbane Road (from Mooloolaba Esplanade).

Traffic control is on site and will assist motorists and pedestrians as required.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

- **Wednesday 27 April to Monday 23 May:**
Kapala Street temporary road closure
- **Wednesday 23 May to Monday 18 July:**
Tarcoola Street temporary road closure
- **Wednesday 27 April to Thursday 28 July:**
Brisbane Road/First Avenue partial road closure:

What to expect during these works?

These works are major road works with large machinery operating. Intermittent medium-high level noise is to be expected.

Dust mitigation measures, including dust monitors are in place.

Alternative footpaths are in place.

Detour signage is in place to communicate traffic changes to motorists.

Shops open signage is in place.

Please allow an extra five-ten minutes of travel time during this period.
