About these works

Council is continuing to relocate electrical infrastructure in Caloundra. Energex, will undergo overhead power pole and underground relocation works at various locations throughout, Caloundra (weather and site conditions permitting) (refer to figures 1a and 1b).

This involves the following:

- cutting areas of grass verge, footpaths, driveway crossovers and road surfaces
- Relocation of overhead powerlines
- Removal of existing power poles
- Installation of new power poles
- Installation of underground power wiring
- Deenergising & energising of relocated power poles

For safety reasons some temporary changes to traffic will be required. Local access will remain to homes and businesses, sometimes under the instructions of traffic control or via detours. Signage will be in place.

Contractors and specialist equipment will be on site with intermittent noise expected.

In some cases **temporary interruptions to power supply** will be required (which may impact other services such as telecommunications). Energex will provide direct, advance notice to relevant businesses

Upon completion of these works all disturbed areas will be rectified.

Works schedule & changed traffic conditions

**Third Avenue (corner of Third Avenue and Arthur Street). Part section full road closure (section)
Weds 22 to Thurs 23 July inclusive (refer to fig 2)**

A section of Third Avenue and Arthur St will be closed to all traffic. Local access will be available. Detours will be in place for all other traffic (refer to figure 1)

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

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Works will take place on grassed verges/footpaths. Alternative pedestrian access will be in place as required. Two-way traffic will remain with traffic control in place for the following locations (refer to figures 1a and 1b):

- Third Avenue and Arthur Street
Thursday (August 3 to 14)
- Second Avenue, Oval Avenue and Olm Street
Wednesday (August 3 to 14)
- First Avenue and Oval Avenue (August 3 to August 14)
