

# Mooloolaba Foreshore Revitalisation



## May 2026 Update

Stage Two of the Mooloolaba Foreshore Revitalisation project continues with more beachfront parkland, new community facilities and improved accessibility on its way.

This month construction activity progresses across different locations simultaneously throughout the construction site.

Construction will pause for the Labour Day long weekend on Monday 4 May 2026.

Here's a look at what's been happening on site.



## Completed April works

- Ongoing shaping and preparation of embankment ready for seawall terraces
- Construction of new seawall terraces in front of the Surf Club, now at finished level
- Start of planter sections in seawall
- Footpath preparation works in front of the Surf Club

- Underground services installation (electrical and water). This includes works opposite Peninsular and Landmark Resorts.

## This month's (May) activity

- Works in front of the Surf Club include:
  - Footpath works
  - Electrical works
  - Seawall surface works (vapour blasting and sealing)
  - Seawall planter works
  - Landscaping
  - Irrigation installation
- Investigations to confirm underground service locations are underway
- Ongoing shaping and preparation of embankment ready for seawall terraces
- Ongoing construction of new pedestrian access ramp and new seawall terraces in front of existing playground and BBQ area.
- Underground services installation (electrical and stormwater drainage). This includes works opposite Peninsular and Landmark Resorts.
- Foundation construction of new public amenities.
