Project update

The Caloundra Transport Corridor Upgrade is a high priority project for improving access into the Caloundra CBD and surrounding destinations.

The road upgrade and new extension is being delivered between Omrah Avenue and Nicklin Way, in partnership with the Queensland Government and Sunshine Coast Council.

The final design for the overall corridor is expected to be finalised early 2025.

The design takes into consideration delivery outcomes, active transport pathway locations, landscaping and environmental requirements.

Council and the Department of Transport and Main Roads look forward to sharing this with our Stakeholder Interest Group and community in the coming months.

Section 1 early works, including the demolition of properties has been completed.

Section 1 includes upgrades to the existing network and a new separated two-way cycle track and pedestrian pathway, through an environmentally considerate design.

The improved active transport option will encourage walking and riding.

Construction for this section is planned to start in 2025.

Following the appointment of a construction contractor, a more detailed timeframe will be shared with our community.

Council will continue to work with the Queensland Government to secure funds to complete Section 2.
