Stringybark Road Pedestrian and Cycle Bridge April Construction Update

Dear Community Members and Representatives,

Please find **below** the latest construction information for the month of April regarding the Stringybark Road Pedestrian and Cycle Bridge project.

With all major bridge construction works now complete, this month's activity will largely focus on rectification of the construction zone on the Sunshine Motorway.

Day and night works include:

- Installation of new concrete road barriers
- Installation of road guard rails and wire rope barriers
- Line marking

To minimise impacts to busy day time traffic, the majority of these works must be undertaken at night. Night works will therefore take place on intermittent evenings in April, between the hours of 7pm-5am (weather permitting). Night works will NOT be scheduled for the period between Easter and ANZAC Day (Friday 18 April to Friday 25 April inclusive).

Machinery and construction workers will be entering and exiting the construction compound and motorway during the day and night. Traffic control will be in place on the motorway as required and every effort will continue to be made to reduce inconvenience to neighbouring residents.

For safety reasons the reduced speed limit and speed cameras on the motorway in the construction zone must remain in place until all works are complete. Once complete, the usual speed limit of 100km/hr will be reinstated.

We thank you for your continued patience.

We will be issuing our last Construction Notification in early May.
