Brisbane Road (Foote Street to First Avenue), Mooloolaba

About these works

As detailed in our previous construction notifications, as part of the Brisbane Road upgrade, power infrastructure is being improved.

On Friday 3 December between 7am and 5pm Energex will be switching the overhead power supply to the newly installed underground network, along a section of Brisbane Road.

Energex has made direct contact with all relevant properties about temporary power outages expected on Friday 3 December between 8am and 2pm. Please check your letterbox and email inbox for Energex correspondence. If you are a property manager or owner with tenants in place, please brief them accordingly.

If you have not received any notice from Energex your power supply will remain.

The timing of these works has been determined to minimise impacts to traffic flow along busy Brisbane Road, allow residents to prepare for work/school (including school drop-off and pick up) and ensure that local residents and businesses are not impacted by power outages at night.

Please see the map on page 2 for the location of these works.

What to expect during these works?

For safety reasons some on street parking will be temporarily unavailable between Foote Street and First Avenue on Brisbane Road while these Energex works are taking place.

Nearby residents and businesses can expect intermittent, medium level noise.

Exclusion zones will be applied around live overhead powerlines with registered spotter staff in place for worker and community safety.

Temporary alternative pedestrian pathways and pedestrian crossings will be in place.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Two-way traffic will remain on Brisbane Road. Stop and go traffic control will be in operation as required.

No road closures or detours are expected

Please allow an extra 10 minutes of travel time during this period.

Bus stops

All TransLink bus stops on Brisbane Road and surrounding streets will remain operational.

Access to homes and businesses

Access will remain available for local residents and staff and customers of businesses. Traffic control will assist as required.
