

## To the Resident

### New Footpath – Wharf Road, Bli Bli

#### Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to improving and maintaining pathway networks across our region.

A new footpath will soon be constructed, spanning 135m along the southern side of Wharf Road, Bli Bli. The new 1.8m-wide path connects and extends the existing footpath on David Low Way.

Please refer to the location of works in figure 1 overleaf.

This project is part of staged works which aims to provide a new concrete footpath through the entirety of Wharf Road.

One tree near David Low Way will be removed to allow the new pathway to be built. A new tree will be planted close by.

#### Start date

Works are expected to start Monday 22 January 2024 and be finished within two weeks, weather and site conditions permitting.

#### Property access and parking

Property access should not be affected during works. However, construction crews will contact residents prior to starting any works which may affect property access.

On-street parking along Wharf Road may be limited at times for the safety of pedestrians, road users and contractors.

Thank you for your patience while we deliver these necessary works to improve safety and connection.
