


Minor finishing works and planting

We are pleased to report that the new 160 metre long section of the Caloundra Headland Coastal Pathway Boardwalk is expected to open to our community on Saturday 13 July (weather permitting).

The Coastal Pathway takes advantage of our spectacular coastline that is enjoyed by residents and visitors. People can explore the coastline by walking, jogging or cycling on a combination of on and off road networks as part of the total 73 kilometre long coastal pathway route from Bells Creek in the south to Coolum in the north.

Although the coastal pathway and boardwalk will be open, minor works will continue to take place for the next month or so. These include some electrical works and planting and are not expected to have any impact on our community.
