

Construction Notification 21 September 2021

Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade Project Stages 2 & 3 – Brisbane Road, Mooloolaba

Project number: H3747

Day and night works - underground services relocations Brisbane Road, Kapala Street and Foote Street Thursday 23 September to Thursday 7 October 2021 (all works weather and site conditions permitting)

As advised in our previous construction notifications, underground services are being relocated and upgraded as part of the Brisbane Road upgrade. This includes telecommunications, water and electrical services.

For safety reasons and due to the volume of traffic on Brisbane Road some works must take place at night.

23 September – 7 October, 7am to 5pm Water and electrical relocation work Brisbane Road, Kapala Street and Foote Street

The installation of watermain and electrical conduits will occur from Thursday 23 September to Thursday 7 October on Brisbane Road, Kapala Street and Foote Street. This includes:

- A section of watermain in the road verge at 37-39 Brisbane Road
- A section of watermain at Foote Street near the Shell service station
- Sections of electrical conduits along Brisbane Road between Hancock Street and Mayes Canal corridor. These conduits will be installed across driveways in the red shaded area shown in Figure 1. The construction contractor will liaise directly with affected residents and businesses in advance of these works.

23 - 30 September, 8pm to 6am and 5 - 7 October, 8pm to 6am Water, telecommunications and electrical relocation work Brisbane Road

The installation of telecommunications, watermain and electrical conduits will occur from Thursday 23 September to Thursday 30 September and again from Tuesday 5 October to Thursday 7 October on Brisbane Road.

Trenches will be dug across Brisbane Road to house these conduits. Once the conduits are in place the trenches will then be backfilled. A temporary asphalt (bitumen) layer will be placed until the final asphalt layer is applied at the completion of Stages 2 and 3 works.

What to expect during these works?

Nearby businesses and residents should expect intermittent, medium-level construction noise during the day and night. Trucks, excavators and sucker trucks will be in operation.

Some resident's and businesses' driveways will be temporarily inaccessible for small periods of time while trenches are dug across driveways. The construction contractor will liaise directly with impacted properties in advance of these works.

The water supply may be temporarily impacted as the 'change over' is made from the old to the new watermain. Unitywater will inform residents and businesses of any temporary changes to supply.

No interruptions to telecommunications or electricity supply are expected.

To safely undertake these works partial lane closures, detours and traffic control will be in place as required.

Some pedestrian footpaths will be temporarily closed with alternative routes provided.

Signage will be in place to help redirect motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.
