

**Mooloolaba Transport Corridor
Upgrade (MTCU) Project
Stage 1B – Walan Street, Mooloolaba**

**Night works – line marking and Unitywater works
Wednesday 10 and Thursday 11 March 6pm – 6am
Walan Street closed to through traffic
(all works weather and site conditions permitting)**

As part of the final works of the Stage 1B Walan Street upgrade, line marking and Unitywater water main connection works will take place later this week.

For safety reasons and to minimise inconvenience to residents and businesses these works must be undertaken at night.

Each evening, Walan Street will be closed to through traffic. Detours will be in place via Goonawarra Drive/Tarcoola Avenue, First Avenue and Muraban Street. Local access to homes and businesses in the closed area will be available via traffic control.

Line marking Walan Street – Wednesday 10 and Thursday 11 March

Following on from the recent asphalt (bitumen works) permanent line marking will be applied along Walan Street.

Unitywater works - Thursday 11 March

Unitywater will be undertaking a major water main connection at the corner of Smith Street and Walan Streets (adjacent to the Pandanus building).

This will involve some cutting of the footpath surface and underground excavation to reach the water main.

Unitywater will keep residents and businesses informed of any temporary changes to water supply.

What to expect during these works

Line marking: Nearby residents and businesses should expect minimal noise impacts from the line marking. Work crews and minimal machinery will be on site.

Unitywater works: Intermittent medium-level construction noise should be expected. Where possible, noisier works will take place earlier in the evening.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Walan Street will be closed to through traffic each evening.

Detours will be in place via Goonawarra Drive, Tarcoola Avenue, First Avenue and Muraban Street.

Signage will help to direct motorists and pedestrians.
