### Construction overview

Construction is continuing on the new 160-metre-long section of Caloundra Headland Coastal Pathway Boardwalk. This section forms part of a total 73 kilometre long coastal pathway route from Bells Creek in the south to Coolool in the north.

### Temporary changes to traffic conditions – The Esplanade and Centaur Park

#### Until Friday 8 December (continued). The Esplanade temporary closure (day and night) between Albert St and Margaret St

Detours remain in place via Burgess, Margaret and Albert Streets with signage erected to help redirect motorists. Pedestrians and cyclists remain detoured via alternative pathways.

Thank you to our community for your cooperation to date.

#### Until Friday 8 December (continued). Retaining wall construction.

The construction of a concrete block retaining wall and connection slabs will continue throughout November.

While these works will take place during the day only, the temporary road closure will be in effect during the day and night for safety reasons.

#### Until Saturday 25 November (continued). Day works only, piling works for boardwalk

Small diameter steel rods (piles) will continue to be drilled and grouted into the rock to form the foundations for the new boardwalk.

While these works will take place during the day only, the temporary road closure will be in effect during the day and night for safety reasons.

#### Monday 30 October 2023 – June 2024. Centaur Park. Access road and car park closure (temporary). Pedestrian access remains.

For safety reasons the access road and car park area at Centaur Park will be temporarily closed to all vehicles until the completion of the project, June 2024. Traffic control and signage will be in place. Parking is available in nearby streets.

Pedestrian access remains available to the park and pathway.
