Caloundra Transport Corridor Upgrade April 2024 Update

 Section One - Ongoing early works including demolition works, ground remediation and underground services relocation

 Various locations – Gosling Street, Bowman Road, Oval Avenue, Third Avenue, Caloundra

 Traffic control in operation as required

Works overview

As part of the Caloundra Transport Corridor Upgrade (CTCU) project, early works for Section One of the two section project are taking place.

These works include the relocation of underground services such as power, water and telecommunications, the demolition of properties, and ground remediation to accommodate this important road and active transport corridor.

What to expect during these works

Demolition contractor, Murphy Builders is continuing with demolition works. All relevant permits are in place and tests have been undertaken on the land and buildings as required, including for the presence and safe handling of asbestos.

It is expected that all properties will be demolished by end-May 2024 with additional

clearing of the sites completed by July 2024. Underground services relocations and ground remediation works will continue through to July 2024.

Moderate to high levels of intermittent noise can be expected during the day during all works. Access will remain available to local residences and businesses.
