Caloundra Headland Coastal Pathway - Boardwalk

April 2024 Update



Construction activity – concrete cutting and demolition of existing (old) pathway



Various dates over the next month – concrete cutting currently scheduled for Mondays in April (weather and site conditions permitting)

Temporary road closure remaining in place until late May 2024



The Esplanade - section between Albert Street and Margaret Street



Detours in place. Pedestrian and traffic control in place. Construction crew and machinery on site and roadway.

Construction overview

Construction is continuing on the new 160 metre long section of Caloundra Headland Coastal Pathway Boardwalk and is expected to be complete in June 2024 (weather and site conditions permitting). This section forms part of a total 73 kilometre long coastal pathway route from Bells Creek in the south to Coolum in the north.

For safety reasons during construction temporary changes to traffic conditions are required. This also allows the construction team to work more efficiently and reduce the construction duration, thereby minimising inconvenience to residents and visitors.

Construction activity

Over the coming weeks the construction team will be demolishing the old concrete pathway. This will require the use of concrete cutters to break up and remove large sections of the old pathway.

To minimise inconvenience to nearby residents the concrete cutting has been scheduled to take place one day a week for several weeks, in blocks of 3 – 4 hours at a time.

Concrete cutting dates has commenced this week and will continue now each Monday including 8, 15, 22 and 29 April (weather permitting) .

The nature of these works means that intermittent noise can be expected during the day. Council apologises in advance of these works and assures residents that works will be completed as quickly as possible.

Other April construction activity will see continued:

- construction of the boardwalk and decking
- construction of the concrete pathway
- electrical works
- landscaping

Large machinery will be in place onsite and working from the roadway.
