Energex works, temporary power outage and changed traffic conditions Brisbane Road (Foote Street to Bindaree Crescent)

Thursday 12 August 7am – 5pm

All works weather and site conditions permitting

About these works

As detailed in our previous construction notifications, as part of the Brisbane Road upgrade, power infrastructure is being improved.

On Thursday 12 August between 7am and 5pm Energex will continue to install power poles and relocate overhead power lines along a section of Brisbane Road.

To safely undertake these works and protect the community, some temporary changes to traffic conditions are required.

Energex has already made direct contact with relevant properties about temporary power outages between 8am and 3pm. Please check your letterbox and email for Energex correspondence. If you have not received anything from Energex your power supply will remain.

The timing of these works has been determined to minimise impacts to traffic flow along busy Brisbane Road, allow residents to prepare for work/school (including school drop-off and pick up) and ensure that local residents and businesses are not impacted by power outages at night.

What to expect during these works?

On street parking will be temporarily unavailable on Brisbane Road between Foote Street and Bindaree Crescent.

Nearby residents and businesses can expect intermittent, medium level noise and the operation of heavy machinery including crane lift trucks.

Exclusion zones will be applied around live overhead powerlines with registered spotter staff in place for worker and community safety.

Temporary alternative pedestrian pathways and pedestrian crossings will be in place.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Thursday 12 August 9am – 3pm

Stop and go traffic between Foote Street and Bindaree Crescent, Brisbane Road

Two-way traffic will remain on Brisbane Road.

For safety reasons partial lane closures with stop and go traffic control will be in operation when large power poles are lifted into place.

No road closures or detours are expected

Please allow an extra 10 minutes of travel time during this period.

Bus stops

The TransLink bus stops on Brisbane Road adjacent to the Mooloolaba Bowls Club and Mooloolaba Central Motel (stops #301698 and #301699 – Routes 600, 611 and 615) will remain operational.

Access to homes and businesses

Access will remain available for local residents and staff and customers of businesses. Traffic control will assist as required.
