### Construction overview

With the reopening today (15.9.22) of the Brisbane Road-Walan Street-Hancock Street intersection, traffic has been moved to the western side of Brisbane Road in preparation for construction for the two eastern side lanes and footpath.

Private access points (local traffic only) have been provided through the closed construction area to ensure access remains available for businesses and residents on the eastern side of the street.

Subject to weather and site conditions, the estimated completion of all major roadworks remains as late 2022. Minor works including some landscaping and pathway construction will continue into early 2023.

The construction team will continue to liaise directly with residents and businesses during these works.

### Waste collection services (general, recycling and green waste)

Residents and businesses are advised that waste collection services will continue as normal.

Please place your general, recycling and green waste bins on the street, in your usual location, prior to 6am on the day of your waste service.

Collections will occur between 6.00am and 6.00pm on that day (unless otherwise advised).

If required, the construction contractor and waste contractors will move the bins for collection, before returning the empty bins to the original location

Please collect your empty bins and return them to your private property as usual.

If your bin is not collected for any reason, please contact the MTCU team directly via the details below and we will liaise with waste management services to rectify.
