Night works. Brisbane Road & Walan Street & Hancock Street intersection Sunday 29 August – Friday 3 September 6pm – 6am

All works weather and site conditions permitting

About these works

As part of the Brisbane Road upgrade underground services are being upgraded. This includes sewer and water main works.

From Sunday 29 August to Wednesday 1 September, sections of sewer pipe along Brisbane Road, Walan Street and Hancock Street will be relined as part of important maintenance works.

Relining of the pipes does not require any digging or trenching as machinery can access the pipes from existing manholes on the road.

On Thursday 2 September water main materials will be relocated from Walan Street across Brisbane Road to Hancock Street. A portion of Brisbane Road will be closed during these works (see map attached). Detours will be in place.

What to expect during these works?

Relining of the sewer pipes is a multi-stage process. The sewer lines are first cleaned and then relined on the inside with a PVC structural liner.

Large trucks and specialist machinery are required.

For the water main works large trucks and machinery will be in operation.

During night works intermittent low-medium level noise can be expected including trucks with reversing beepers. Temporary lighting will be in place.

For safety reasons some temporary changes to traffic conditions are required.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Partial lane closures will be in place on Brisbane Road, Walan Street and Hancock Street.

Two-way traffic will be maintained under traffic control. Reduced speed limits will be in place.

At various times, some properties will experience temporary changes to access. The project team will work directly with these residents and businesses.

Please allow an extra 5-10 minutes of travel during this period.
