Construction Notification Stage 2 Early Works

Club Lane new raised shared zone revised dates

Construction from June 16–25, 2025

Construction works will now start on Monday 16 June and extend to Wednesday 25 June (previously 11–20 June).

The date change is due to supplier availability of asphalt (bitumen).

Information about these works was included in our recent Construction Notification on 27 May 2025.

To improve pedestrian safety and access in Mooloolaba a new raised, 'shared' zone will be installed in Club Lane.

Works involve the construction of a raised asphalt (bitumen) crossing area, along with minor drainage works.

During these works pedestrian and vehicle access, along with loading bay access, will remain available to nearby shops, the Surf Club and the Sandcastles building.

To complete these works as quickly and safely as possible, some parking bays adjacent to Arthur Parkyn Park will be temporarily unavailable and used by the construction contractor.

Vehicle and pedestrian traffic control will be in place as required.

Four hours free parking

During all Stage Two works, Council is providing the first four hours of parking free at the [PARKnGO Mooloolaba Central](#) car park.

More than 700 car parks, 54 motorcycle spaces, 50 bicycle spaces and accessible parking spaces are available, all less than 300 metres to Mooloolaba Beach and the foreshore.

This initiative is part of the Mooloolaba Business Activation Plan.

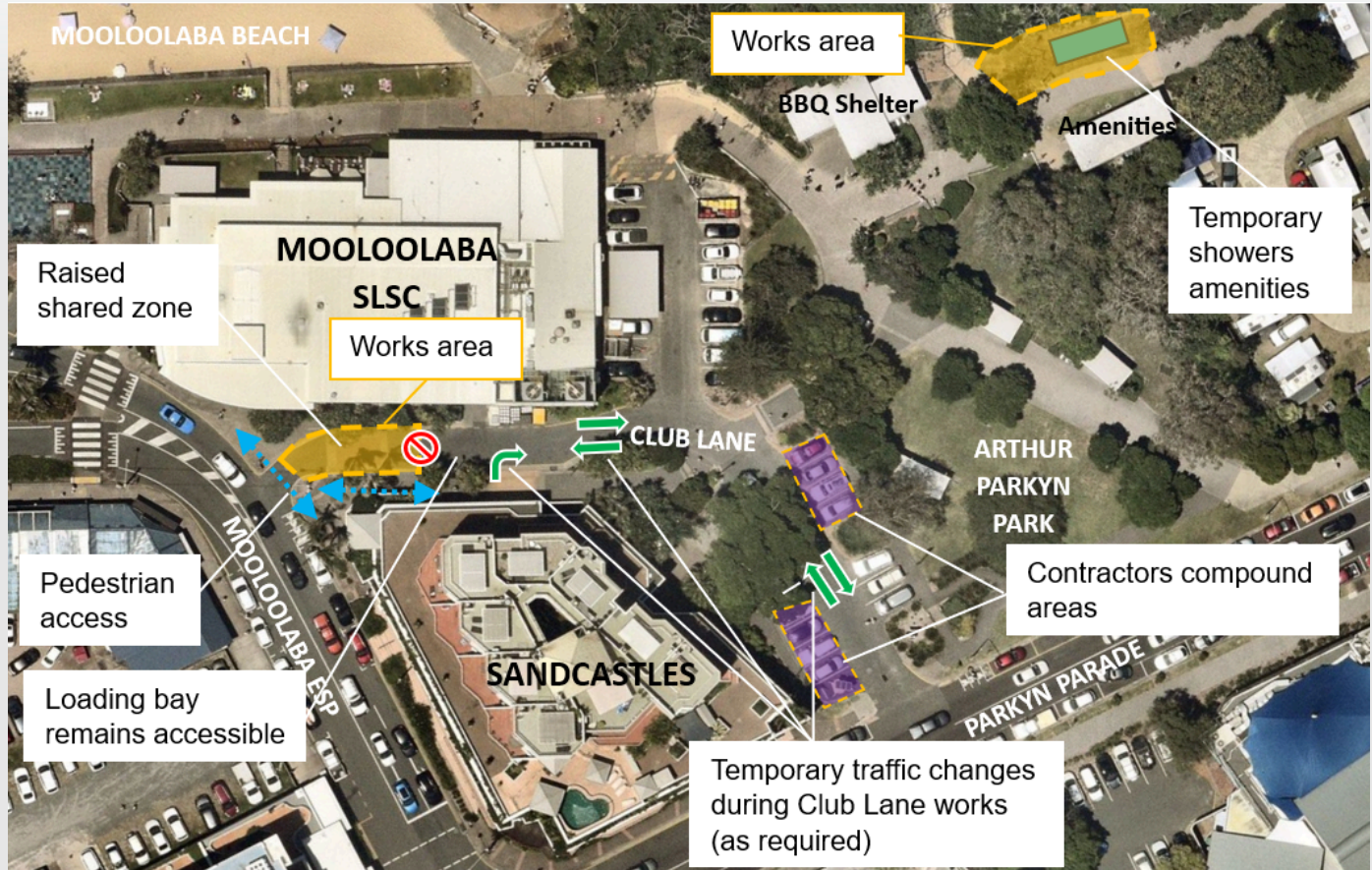
