## **Brisbane Road Upgrade**

Project number: H3747

Stages 2 and 3 Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade

#### Night works. Brisbane Road, Walan Street & Hancock Street intersection Sunday 24 October and Monday 25 October 6pm – 6am All works weather and site conditions permitting

#### About these works

As part of the Brisbane Road upgrade underground services are being upgraded. This includes sewer main works.

From Sunday 24 October to Monday 25 October (both evenings), sections of sewer pipe along Brisbane Road, Walan Street and Hancock Street will be relined as part of important maintenance works.

Relining of the pipes does not require any digging or trenching as machinery can access the pipes from existing manholes on the road.

No interruptions to the sewage network are expected.

These works have been scheduled at night to help minimise inconvenience to the community and avoid impacting daytime traffic along busy Brisbane Road.

Traffic flow will be maintained with some changes to traffic conditions.

#### What to expect during these works?

Relining of the sewer pipes is a multi-stage process. The sewer lines are first cleaned and then relined on the inside with a PVC structural liner. Large trucks and specialist machinery are required.

During these night works intermittent lowmedium level noise can be expected including the use of trucks with reversing beepers.

Temporary lighting will be in place for safety reasons.

# Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Traffic control will be in place on Brisbane Road, Walan Street and Hancock Street.

Two-way traffic will be maintained with traffic being moved onto different areas of the road including opposite lanes as required. Reduced speed limits will be in place.

At various times, some properties will experience temporary changes to access. The project team will work directly with these residents and businesses.

Please allow an extra 5-10 minutes of travel during this period.
